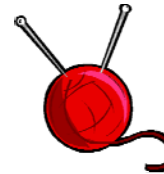

Happy New year, Liberty family!

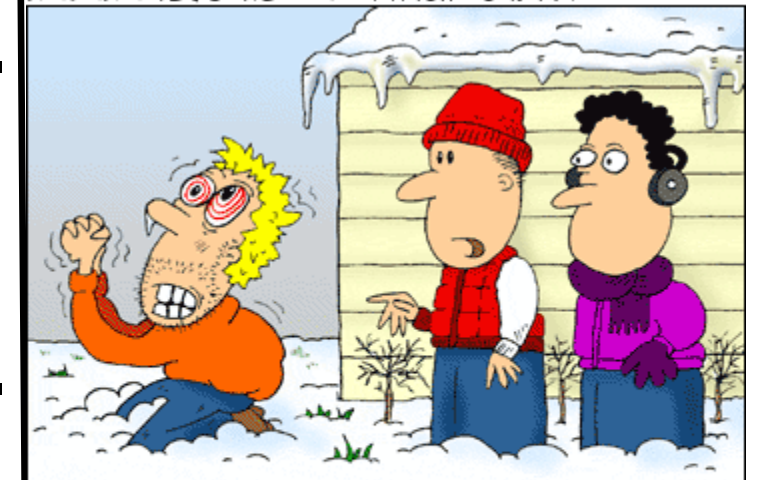
