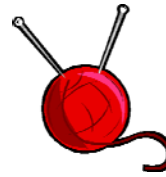
Remember that we need youth and parent participation in our fundraising in order to take advantage of the 1/3, 1/3, and 1/3 allocation of funds for trips.

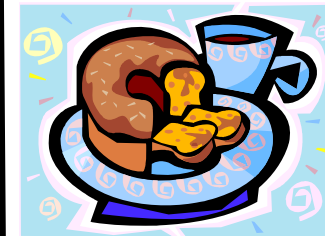
**Ladies Retreat at

This summer we have focused our Children's Ministry lessons around the countries of Columbia and Ecuador. The

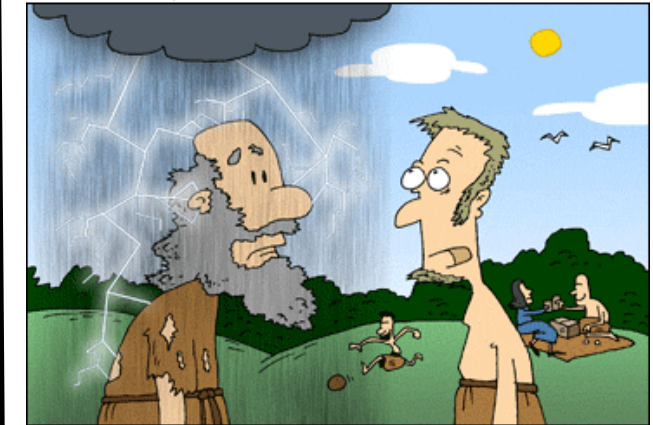
